Creating Databases:

CREATE DB_Name;

Creating Tables:

CREATE TABLE authors (author_name VARCHAR(60),
author_pay int);

Displaying the Data from All Columns in a Table:

SELECT * FROM Tabel_Name;

Obtain Unique Records:

SELECT DISTINCT name, color FROM fruits;

Sorting Data on the Basis of Multiple Columns:

SELECT color, name FROM fruit ORDER BY name DESC, color;

Filtering out Data:

SELECT name, age FROM students WHERE age>=10;



Obtaining Data of a Specific Column without NULL:

SELECT name, color FROM fruit WHERE color IS NOT NULL;

Identify Values Aligning with Specific Pattern:

SELECT id, name FROM animal WHERE name LIKE '%b%';

Mathematical Operators & Using Aliases of Column:

SELECT price - discount as Net_Price FROM
product:

Counting Number of Rows:

SELECT COUNT (id) FROM product;

Determine Sum of Values in Columns:

SELECT SUM (price) FROM product;

Obtaining Data from Specific Columns:

SELECT name, color FROM fruit WHERE color IS NOT NULL;
